Monday, March 4

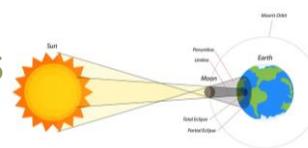

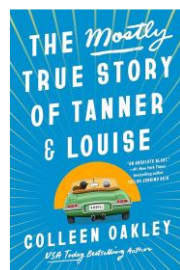
