Make IT AT home

Whisk Dragonfly

Provided in the kits:

- Wire whisk
- · Wooden bead
- · Craft wire
- · Mini pony beads



<u>SHARP OBJECT WARNING</u> - For your convenience, we have snipped one of the whisk loops to act as the "antennae" of the dragonfly. Please use care when handling the whisk as the snipped wire is sharp.

Instructions:

- 1. Grabbing the top two loops of the whisk, pull the loop in your right hand to the right, and your loop in your left hand to the left.
 - Make sure to leave the two upright wires in the middle as you adjust the loops.
 - This will create the bottom wings.
- 2. Grabbing the next two loops of the whisk, repeat step 1.
 - Make sure to leave the two upright wires in the middle as you adjust the loops.
 - This will create the top wings.
- 3. Work the wings around until you have them all facing "forward", mimicking the image of butterfly wings.
- 4. All that remains upright will be the snipped wires or "antennae".
- 5. Thread both "antennae" through the wooden bead pushing down until the bead feels secure.
- 6. Bend the antennae out slightly to hold the bead in place.
- 7. Using a piece of craft wire, center the wire in down the middle of a wing and wrap the wire around the "body" to secure in place.
- 8. Thread beads on the wire until you reach the outer edge of the wing.
- 9. Wrap the wire around the outer edge of the wing to secure in place.
- 10. Trim excess wire if necessary
- 11. Repeat steps 7-10 for all four wings.
